## NOTES

- Note 1 Where a candidate is commonly known by some title he/she may be described by his/her title as if it were his/her surname.
- Note 2 A person's electoral number consists of the distinctive letter(s) and number(s) of the Polling District in which he/she is registered together with his/her number in the Register, eg **AB80** (defining the Polling District) **123** (number in the Register). This can be obtained by calling the **Electoral Registration Office in Campbeltown on 01586 555300**.
- Note 3 An elector, who must be 16 years of age on the day of the election, may not sign, as proposer or seconder, more nomination papers than there are vacancies to be filled in the Wind Farm Trust area.
- Note 4 A person whose name is entered in the Register of Electors may not sign, a nomination paper as proposer or seconder if the entry gives as the date on which he/she will become of voting age a date later than the day fixed for the poll.
- Note 5 A candidate may submit a biography/statement in support of his/her nomination. In the event of a contested election, a copy of the biography/statement submitted will be included with the ballot papers sent to every elector eligible to vote in that contested election.

The biography/statement must be received by the Returning Officer attached to the nomination paper when the nomination is lodged and must not exceed 100 words. The biography/statement should be typed or written in block capitals. Should the biography/statement not be received with the nomination paper, or should it exceed 100 words the Returning Officer will disregard the biography/statement and in the event of a contested election it will not be included with the ballot papers sent to every elector eligible for vote in that contested election. The Returning Officer will not edit a biography/statement in any way.

The Returning Officer will not publish any biography/statement which, in his sole opinion, contains any material considered defamatory, obscene, or otherwise would be in breach of any law.

- Note 6 If there are more than three candidate nominations received, then a community ballot will be held to determine which candidates will be elected as Trustees. In this instance all candidates will be contacted after the closing date (23rd April 2025) to notify them and guidance as to the election process will be provided at that time.
